Verticals





All vertical lines (windows, door frames, mirrors, cabinets...) should be perfectly vertical in the photo.

Tools / Settings —

Turn your camera's flash off, set the shutter to a 2s Timer and place your camera on a tripod to shoot perfectly level.

Use your camera's Exposure Compensation to adjust the brightness of the resulting photo.

Find a Pro —

Find a professional photographer to build a relationship with. Invite them to RESA, hire them and refer work to them.
